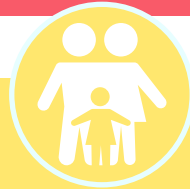
▶ SERVICES FOR QUALIFYING FAMILIES AT NO COST ◀

Early Head Start supports the growth and development of parents as *they* support the growth and development of their children.



FOR CHILDREN:

- » Weekly in-home education by a trained child family advocate
- » Services for children with disabilities
- » Assistance in obtaining medical care for your child
- » Nutrition and health information for your child
- » Group socialization
- » Developmental screenings



FOR PARENTS:

- » Resources, referrals and social services support
- » Transportation assistance
- » Child care during group activities or parent trainings
- » Leadership and skill development through Policy Council
- » Parent Committee meetings provide opportunities to share ideas
- » Access to computers and materials to support success in Parent Resource Center



ELIGIBILITY

Your family may be eligible if:

- » You are currently pregnant
- » You are the parent/caregiver of a child under 3 years of age
- » You live in the following zip codes: 19120, 19121, 19122, 19124, 19126, 19132, 19133, 19140, 19141
- » You have a child with a disability
- » You meet the federal income guidelines
